

## Fellowship, Inc. Summary of Rules and Policies

Revised 2020

*Fellowship, inc. is member-owned and operated. Each current member is equally responsible for its care and upkeep. The Board is elected to help oversee the care and upkeep of Fellowship and transact all the business of the corporation. If a member observes an infraction of the rules and policies, they are encouraged to correct the situation.*

*The corporation shall not be responsible for any accident or injury to any person, member or non-member, which takes place upon the property of the corporation.*

- Admissions to Fellowship, Inc. Is restricted to paid member families and to their accompanying guests. Member families are those identified on the member's application and living within the family household.
- The lifeguard has the authority to prohibit any activities in the pool or pool areas that he/she deems to be unsafe. All swimmers must cooperate and comply with the lifeguard's instructions and requests.
- Pool hours are 10:30am – 8:00pm daily.
- Lifeguard is on duty 1:00pm – 8:00pm daily until August 1<sup>st</sup>. Then Lifeguard will be on duty Saturday and Sunday 1:00pm – 8:00pm
- NO guests allowed when a lifeguard is not present
- All members must pay their \$100 work day fee or participate in a work day by opening day or membership will be temporarily suspended until funds are received and confirmed by a board member.
- All guests must be accompanied by a host member all members and their guests must sign in at the pool desk before entering the pool, tennis area, or playground during the time when the pool is open. Each member family is allowed to bring up to 20 guests per season. Guests in attendance to a scheduled member party are not counted towards the 20 guest limit. Guests must pay \$5.00 per visit at the time of their entry into the facility regardless of which facilities they use. Members who have out of town family house guests staying in their home for an extended period of time may petition the Board for a waiver of these guest rules. (each year)
- Members 17 and younger must be accompanied by an adult member 18+ unless they are life guard certified when a life guard is not on duty.
- Children 13 and younger must be accompanied by an adult member 18 and over at all times.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted on any Fellowship property. Pool, tennis courts, playground, etc. are alcohol free. Cigarette and pipe smoking and vaping are permitted ONLY in the parking lot and in such areas designated, Smoking and vaping is forbidden inside the fenced pool area and the fenced tennis court area at all times.
- Amplified music is allowed at the discretion of the lifeguard
- During adult swim all children aged 13 and under must exit the pool for 15 minutes.
- Sign in is required.
- Members are responsible for unlocking and relocking the gate open arriving and exiting the pool. Pool gate should be locked or latched AT ALL TIMES.
- Members are responsible for cleaning up any trash and toys used during their visit. Pool furniture should be straightened and umbrellas should also be closed upon leaving the pool. All trash shall be placed in trash containers If using the pool after lifeguard hours.
- Any pool related issues included but not limited to cloudy water, feces in pool, vomit in pool, etc. MUST be reported to the CPO and Board IMMEDIATELY and ALL members must exit the pool. Necessary numbers are posted by the pool telephone and a sign will be available to hang on the gate indicating that the pool is closed.
- Any rules violations or trespassing should be reported to the board immediately.
- Shower before entering pool
- Adults shall not swim alone

- Any child not potty trained and/or under three years old must wear snug fitting plastic pants or a water resistant swim diaper.
- Do not swim if the suction outlets are missing, broken, or not clearly visible from the deck.
- NO glass allowed in or around the pool.
- Do NOT swallow the pool water
- Diving is permitted only in 9 foot diving well.
- Only one person shall use or be on the diving board or in the area immediately in front of the diving board at any one time.
- No floats in the deep end.
- Children, 3 years and under, must have a parent or guardian within touching distance in the pool.
- There shall be no running, boisterous conduct, no profanity or vulgarity, no loud music, no vandalism, and no destruction or damage of club property. Parents shall be responsible for the conduct of their children and guests.
- Do NOT swim if you had diarrhea within the past two weeks
- NO animals are allowed in the pool or pool enclosure, except service animals are allowed on the deck.
- When thunder is heard, pool must be cleared for 30 minutes. Pool must be cleared for 1 hour for lightening.
- If you are the last to leave the pool area, please turn off restroom lights, close the doors to the restrooms, and lock all of the gates including the front gate.
- Members must sign a waiver agreeing to these rules prior to participating in swim at your own risk swim times.

**Parties**

1. All parties are subject to the approval by the Board of Directors. All requests for scheduling of a party must be received by the Board at least 7 days before the party.
2. A deposit of \$50 must be received by the Board prior to the party. The sponsor of the party is responsible for ensuring that each member of the party signs in and the \$5.00 guest fee is paid for each nonmember, regardless of the extent of the facility use.
3. Parties must pay for an additional lifeguard for the party hours at the rate of \$10.00 per hour.
4. The party area must be cleaned by the party sponsor immediately at the completion of the party or the \$50 deposit is forfeited.
